- In Point 11 (c), Opening of covers containing question papers: Please read:

The *inner polythene* cover should ~~not be opened earlier than half an hour~~ before the hours fixed for commencement of the examinations.

The cover should not be opened earlier than half an hour before the hours fixed for commencement of the examinations.

- In Point 23 please read:

A confidential report on the conduct of examination at the centre shall be sent ~~daily~~ in a separate sealed cover to the respective Regional Council Office of the Board with a copy to the Deputy Secretary (Examination) along with Absentee Statement (EMU/C/31A).

A confidential report on the conduct of examination at the centre shall be sent in a separate sealed cover to the respective Regional Council Office of the Board with a copy to the Deputy Secretary (Examination) along with Absentee Statement (EMU/C/31A).

- In Annexure – VI, Point-(c) 2nd Para please read:

Members of the visiting team are entitled to visit to the examination venue as well as to the examination rooms showing their identity cards. They should have easy access to the examination room without any prior intimation; vide clause no. xxxii in Kolkata Gazette Notification on 04.07.2001. Board nominees are also entitled to visit the examination venue and rooms, as and when they feel necessary.

Members of the visiting team or Board's nominees, at the time of their visit to the examination venue want to enter into an examination hall shall obtain the consent of the officer-in-charge/Centre Secretary/Supervisor as the case of may be, depending upon who is present at the venue.
