Attention of all Heads of Institution is drawn to the changes in academic session in our State in school level education Vide G.O. No. 635-SE(S)/10M-39/2009 dt 18.6.09.. Accordingly, the revised academic calendar as detailed below, will come into effect from the current academic session 2009-2010 :

Revised Annual Academic Calendar for the session 2009-2010 (May 2009 to February 2010)

Third	Not before 2 nd week of September 2009 / before Puja vacation	30 marks	30 marks	Oral 10 marks- SL for VI-VIII. For class IX 10 marks for Maths objectives & 20 to EVS practical.
Fourth	2 nd week of November 2009	20 marks	20 marks	EVS practical- 20 marks for VI to VII & 10 marks for Maths objectives for classes VI to IX.
Second Remedial	1 st week of December 2009	25 marks	25 marks	For the students with learning gaps and for the subject(s) in which needed.
Fifth	Latest by 1 st week of January, 2010	10 marks	10 marks	For classes VI-VIII - only oral 10 marks for 1 st Language, 2 nd Language, Mathematics, Physical Science, Life Science, History, Geography, Practical 10 marks for EVS. Project work is desirable for the subjects- Ph.Sc., L.Sc., Hist., Geo., in place of oral test. Syllabus earmarked for 5 th Unit Test for all subjects to be taught. For class IX- Oral 10 marks for each subject but 20 for 1 st Language and 10 marks for EVS practical
Summative Evaluation / Annual Examination	Not before 2 nd week of January 2010	100 marks	100 marks	For classes V-IX *Summative Evaluation / Annual Examination for classes V-VIII would be taken for 100 marks on the syllabi for different subjects as already earmarked in the Handbooks on Unit & Summative Evaluation for Classes V - IX

- N.B. :**
1. Counting of unit test score for students appearing in remedial tests :- The average marks of 1st and 2nd unit tests to be added to the marks obtained in the 1st remedial test and similarly the average marks of the 3rd and 4th unit tests is to be added to the marks obtained in the 2nd remedial test.
 2. Weightage- 50% weightage to unit test score and 50% to summative score for final result.
 3. Academic calendar for class X remains unchanged.
 4. All other directions of the existing Annual Academic Calendar will remain unchanged.
 5. Session for 2010-2011 starts on and from 1st March, 2010.
