A second set lettery for left over candidates in each category i.e. separate lettery for the left over SC candidates, separate for left over ST candidates and separate lottery for left 11) over OBC candidates to select the candidates from the reserved quota in each category.

This will be effective form the next academic session i.e. 2012 in all Govt. / Govt. aided schools across the State of West Bengal for admission of students in elementary classes.
