Sub: Mobilisation of students to The Science Express - A Unique Exhibition on Wheels


Sir,

As part of this campaign RVPSP has developed an exhibition train "Science Express" in collaboration with Germany. This state of the art exhibition will take visitors to a fascinating expedition into different issues of modern science through 12 thematic modules. "Science Express" was flagged off on 30th October 2007 from Safdarjung Railway Station, Delhi. This special train would travel to about 60 selected destinations.
