


C I R C U L A R

Attention of all Heads of Institution is drawn to the fact that since Universalization of Elementary Education (UEE) more or less achieved its goal, it is absolutely necessary to push this vision towards Universalization of Secondary Education (USE). The nation has outlined objective to enhance the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) for classes IX to X at the national level to 75% by the end of 11th five Year Plan and 100% at the national level by the year 2017. Keeping conformity with the National Level priorities the Government of West Bengal is making a convergent effort for effective implementation of Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) in the State. Major objectives of such Abhiyan are Access, Success, Quality, Equity and Systematic Reforms. To address quality issues the thrust is given upon Teachers Training. The West Bengal Board of Secondary Education has made an elaborate arrangement for Orientation of Teachers, Heads of Institution, Inspectors and other stakeholders and consequently subject specific orientation packages have been prepared. Orientation packages on CCCE and Grading, Heads of the Institution orientation, Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Special intervention programme for SC/ST and other weaker sections have been designed. Such orientation programme will be organized in cascade mode starting from State level to base level.

The capacity building of teachers and Heads of Institution can only make the entire school education system effective and relevant to the present day parental expectations. Thus the system can deliver the best to the tasks as bestowed upon it by the society. The office of the W.B.B.S.E. and the School Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal desire that all schools recognized by the W.B.B.S.E. (aided and unaided) take advantage of the situation for capacity building of their teachers and make the system more meaningful to the clientele.

The time and resources are limited and keeping national priorities and compulsions in mind it is imperative for all teachers and Heads of Institution to comply with the call to attend Workshop /Training /Orientation Programme as and when it is organised at State level and district end. The district level orientation programmes are usually conducted by District Project Officer (DPO), Sarva Shiksha Mission at the district end to cover Resource Person and base level training following guidelines and modules as prepared by the Board. The Board desires further that any ostensible reason should not deter participation in all such orientation/training programme.


