Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Water Resources, RD & GR, Government of India has proposed to organize a three tier painting competition for the children of 6th, 7th and 8th standards at the School, State and National level under IEC (Information, Education and Communication) activities. MoWR, RD & GR has approved the themes of i) Stop River Pollution ii) Nirmal Nadi iii) Contamination of Ground water with Arsenic and other contamination issues for School Level Painting Competition. First three winners from each school would participate in State Level Competition. You are requested to kindly issue suitable direction to organize the said competition in schools under your jurisdiction, as per following guidelines:-


School Level Competition (SLC)

1. The School level competition for the students of 6th, 7th and 8th standards is being launched in all the States/UT's from September, 2015.
2. School Principals are requested to organize painting competition of 2 hours duration at their schools.
3. Drawing materials for the school level would be provided by the schools/students and no cost in this regard would be borne by the Ministry of Water Resources/ Central Ground Water Board.
4. Painting may be made preferably on A3/A4 size paper, though there is no restriction on type/size of paper, paints, crayons, water colour, etc.
5. Three best paintings to be selected by each school and forwarded to the Regional Director, Central Ground Water Board, Eastern Region, Bhujalika, Block-CP 6, Sector - V, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700 091 to reach latest by 20.12.2015.
6. List of class wise participants are to be forwarded to CGWB Office, Kolkata

Painting Details

7. All school Level paintings must contain the following details at the back of the sheet
 - a. Name of student, class, section, roll no.,
 - b. School name & full school address
 - c. Father/Mother's name
 - d. Telephone/Mobile No. of school as well as parents
 - e. All the paintings sent to CGWB must be signed by Principal/Head Master/ Head Mistress of School.
8. Paintings not signed by the school Principal or send directly to this office will not be accepted.
9. Selected paintings are to be sent only to the CGWB Office, ER, Kolkata.
10. All participants will be given a Participation Certificate signed by Regional Director, CGWB and Member Secretary, CGWA.
11. Out of the paintings received from the schools, 50 best paintings will be selected by Juries and will be called for participating in the State Level Painting Competition (SLPC). For SLPC, travelling allowance for the students and two parents/guardians along with an incidental charge of Rs. 1,000/- will be paid.
12. 1st Prize of Rs. 10,000/-, 2nd Prize of Rs. 8,000/- & 3rd Prize of Rs. 5,000/-, 10 Consolation Prizes of Rs 1,000/- each will be paid to the top 13 students in the SLC.
13. On the basis of the SLC, 3 best paintings will be selected for participating in the National Level Competition in New Delhi.
